First, report any and all suspicious activity by calling the Police non-emergency number (748-1251).

Program this number into your cell phone. The rule should be: If in doubt, call the police. Watch for suspicious activity as you enter and leave our neighborhood.

Second, report any instances of vandalism or theft of your property to the NWP Committee: NWP@hamptonparkonline.com.

This information will be kept strictly confidential. Remember, having the information on even the smallest acts of vandalism could be useful in establishing patterns for our patrol officer. Please send your detailed information to NWP@hamptonparkonline.com. Please include: the date, time, location and issue. For example, Sun. Dec. 21, between 11pm and 6am, Mailbox vandalized, and your street address.
